Directions

Driving North

Head north on Interstate 95 from Boston. In Maine I-95 becomes the Maine Turnpike. Stay on the Maine Turnpike to exit 113 in Augusta. Follow Route 3 east to Belfast (48 miles). In Belfast turn left on Route 1. The Belfast Harbor Inn will be on your right about 2 miles.

Driving South

Drive south on Interstate 95 from Canada, take exit 182 B heading east on I-395 in Bangor. Take the exit ramp right onto the Route 202 bypass to Hampden. At the end of the bypass turn left onto Route 9, and at the light turn right onto Route 1A south. Route 1A ends at Coastal Route 1 in Stockton Springs. Travel south for 8 miles and you will see the Belfast Harbor Inn on your left.
